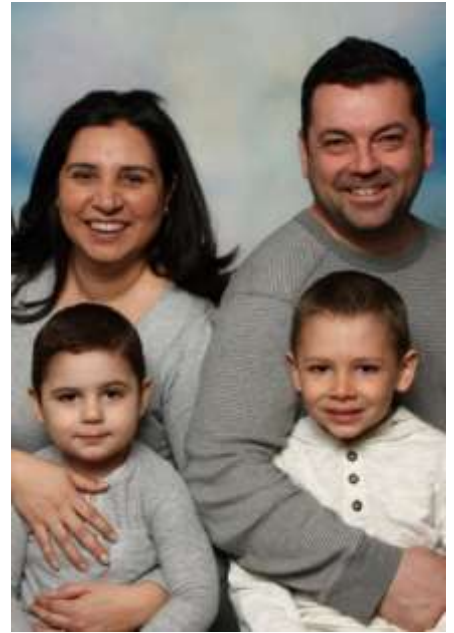


Ms Ana, BA
